HUGHES UPDATE

Hello from Walhalla, South Carolina, USA. It has been just over four years since we as a family came to the USA. It certainly has been challenging for us.

You would think it's easy to come and live amongst everyday English speaking people, but it has its challenges when you realise that the way English is spoken here is different.

A good number of the foodstuffs are similar, but can be prepared for eating very differently, and some of the meals eaten for breakfast, lunch and dinner are very different.

Even the way we may think in some things as a Christian can be different to how Christians think here.

I remember asking for some chips in a restaurant to have with my lunch. Thinking I was going to get a pile of deep fried hot potato chips that you get when you have fish and chips, instead I got a pile of potato chips out of a packet you buy in the shop. I was totally shocked and one person said you got what you asked for. He said you should have asked for french fries. Well, I learnt my lesson and have never asked for chips again but french fries.

When we first came to Walhalla we focussed on bonding with people in the church family. We focussed on this for three years and it has been really good as we have gotten to know everyone and they have gotten to know us.

Earlier this year Jesus placed this scripture strongly on my heart from John 4:38. From the Passion Translation it says, "I have sent you out to harvest a field that you haven't planted, where many others have labored long and hard before you. And now you are privileged to profit from their labors and reap the harvest."

Based on that scripture we set a goal in January 2022 that in the next three years we are believing to double the amount of people we have in the church. We are seeing that happen slowly. It is exciting to see what God is doing here at Faith Center Church.

Omega and I had a burden for the few young children and teenagers we have in the church. We had three small children aged 4-5 years and three teenagers in the church family. Omega and I had a burden to do something like a children's church for these young ones.

We had experimented with some ideas then we had a young couple we know well come along with their two children and they offered to run a children's church. We have since seen the younger ones excited about being in children's church and the teenagers being involved in some leadership roles. It is such a blessing to all of us.

As a family, education for our two boys has been a big adjustment. The system used here took some time to adjust to and get our heads around. Then with us closing the school for a time, finding a school to put the boys in became a big challenge.

At one stage it looked like things were not working out too well for one of our boy's schooling. But by the grace of God and looking prayerfully to Jesus it worked out. Our boys are now doing online Christian Education.

We have been blessed and encouraged with the recent visit of Pr Mike and Kelly Groom, along with Mikaela Groom and Shekinah Sagun. They have blessed us tremendously. Thank you.

USA TRIP REPORT

In August and September, I had the pleasure of joining Pr Mike, Kelly and Mikaela for a missions trip to the USA. We visited multiple places including Los Angeles, San Diego, Atlanta, various spots in North and South Carolina, and of course, Walhalla.

One of my jobs to tick off the list while I was in the USA was to capture some drone footage of the FCC property. The property they have is incredible and it took me a few days to capture all of the drone footage I needed because it was quite large.

It was during those moments where I felt such an overwhelming inspiration for what God has planned for the church in the near future.

FCC has already served a lot of people in the past with their ministries, but now I feel even more excited about how God will use the church to bless and inspire others in the years to come.

Having 'lived like a local' for a few weeks was an overall energising experience for me in many different areas. My heart has deeply grown a very special place for our congregation members at FCC and the town of Walhalla.

I am grateful for the people I met during my visit and for the new friends I have made. This was a trip I will treasure fondly and a place I encourage everyone to keep in your prayers and visit if the opportunity arises.
