Bethel Children's Home TCCFC commits \$200 per month

Bethel Children's Home has been in operation since 1998. All of the children have been affected by the war and unrest in Sri Lanka: displaced, physiologically affected, discriminated against.

SRI LANKA APPEAL

FROM PR SOMANATHAN

In 2022, on the tail end of a vicious battle against the COVID-19 pandemic with limited resources, Sri Lanka has now plunged into the worst economic crisis in our history. As one belonging to the Tamil community that has faced decades-long discrimination and persecution, I can testify that the nature of the existential challenges in Sri Lanka has changed from the 'fear of death' for some to 'fear of starvation and scarcity' for all.

The current economic situation has resulted in shortages in fuel, gas, and food. The shortages have caused prices to soar. Inflation is running at 32%. The reality for Sri Lankans is quickly becoming an impossible situation. Standing in hours long queues for gas and fuel, 13 hour long power cuts, severe limitations on transport, lack of access to medicine and medical treatment, and much more have led to a widely felt hopelessness and disillusionment. With frustrations boiling over we have also witnessed an unprecedented people's movement,

with young and old taking to the streets urging the current regime "to go home."

We are grateful that the ministries and mission work continue to move ahead despite these challenges. As the pastor of my church, it has been incredibly heartbreaking to witness the church community suffering. We continue to encourage one another and stir one another to good works, yet it is clear that we are entering a long season of serious difficulty and lament.

We realise that we are not forgotten by our God or our friends. Passages like Romans 8:35-39 continue to sustain us and press us on in confidence that nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

I am thankful to God for making it possible for us to commence preschool teacher training again this year after the long closure for the past two years. We are still sorting out our program, settling the students in and helping them adjust. It was a bit challenging in the beginning due to different mind sets, religions and also levels of educational backgrounds, but it is through the prayer and support from all of you and the team here at Bethel that they have adjusted well.

We have finished two subjects, with the second one ending with a cultural presentation. The support from staff, students and families was commendable as they came in last minute to show support to the students. The students are doing well and are coping up with each new subject even though it is their first time learning about teaching in a preschool setting.

All of the students are actively involved in programs around Bethel Centre and are cooperating well, despite a few misunderstandings. The pastors are taking turns every Tuesday morning to share God's Word and encourage the students. They are also praying for them.

I appreciate all of your support towards the preschool teacher training and I am looking forward to great things ahead.
