Bethel Children's Home TCCFC commits \$200 per month

Bethel Children's Home has been in operation since 1998. All of the children have been affected by the war and unrest in Sri Lanka: displaced, physiologically affected, discriminated against.

TCCFC sponsors two children, one boy (Nithusan) and one girl (Saruja).

Door of Hope Preschool TCCFC commits \$100 per month

Door of Hope Preschool is located in Vavuniya in the north of Sri Lanka. It is predominantly made up of Tamil speaking children.

SRI LANKA APPEAL

FROM PR SOMANATHAN

In 2022, on the tail end of a vicious battle against the COVID-19 pandemic with limited resources, Sri Lanka has now plunged into the worst economic crisis in our history. As one belonging to the Tamil community that has faced decades-long discrimination and persecution, I can testify that the nature of the existential challenges in Sri Lanka has changed from the 'fear of death' for some to 'fear of starvation and scarcity' for all.

The current economic situation has resulted in shortages in fuel, gas, and food. The shortages have caused prices to soar. Inflation is running at 32%. The reality for Sri Lankans is quickly becoming an impossible situation. Standing in hours long queues for gas and fuel, 13 hour long power cuts, severe limitations on transport, lack of access to medicine and medical treatment, and much more have led to a widely felt hopelessness and disillusionment. With frustrations boiling over we have also witnessed an unprecedented people's movement,

with young and old taking to the streets urging the current regime "to go home."

We are grateful that the ministries and mission work continue to move ahead despite these challenges. As the pastor of my church, it has been incredibly heartbreaking to witness the church community suffering. We continue to encourage one another and stir one another to good works, yet it is clear that we are entering a long season of serious difficulty and lament.

We realise that we are not forgotten by our God or our friends. Passages like Romans 8:35-39 continue to sustain us and press us on in confidence that nothing can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

The long awaited vision is becoming a reality. The prophet Habakkuk states "the vision is for an appointed time, though it is slow in coming, wait for it because it will surely come to pass."

For years we have taught under poor conditions and have faced constant threats of flooding. Soon we will have an excellent environment for the teaching and training of students, as well as proper facilities for Zoom lectures and visual presentations.

This facility will include offices for our course principals, and a preschool that will be open to the community and will provide our preschool teachers with practical experience.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

We are working in partnership with Global Development Group (GDG) to raise funds for a new training centre and preschool facility at BITC.

One of the most effective ways to empower men, women and children in PNG is through education. We are embarking on this project to equip people from PNG and beyond.

The major objective of this three-year project is:

To have a fully functioning educational facility that will empower men, women and children through the provision of early childhood education and vocational training.

We have developed three main goals that we are aiming to achieve within this project.

GOAL ONE

Construct an educational facility that will be used for a preschool and vocational training.

The outcome of this goal is to have a fully functioning educational facility that is equipped with furniture and resources needed to run a preschool and vocational training.

GOAL TWO

Empower men and women through the provision of vocational training courses.

The outcome of this goal is that men and women are provided with an opportunity to gain valuable training that will increase their employability and improve their livelihoods.

GOAL THREE

Empower children through the provision of early childhood education.

The outcome of this goal is that by accessing quality preschool education, children are better prepared for primary school and are more likely to reach higher educational outcomes.
