Benjamin and Asinate Wari TCCFC commits \$100 per month

Benjamin and Asinate Wari are serving as missionaries in Vanuatu. Benjamin is from Papua New Guinea (PNG) and Asinate is from Fiji.

They are doing a great job ministering to the community they are located in. In March 2024 they began a preschool on the property they are living on - Bethel Christian Preschool Banban. In the same month they also began a church - Banban Christian Centre.

Bethel Children's Home has been in operation since 1998. All of the children come from the Tamil minority ethnic group that has been discriminated against for many years. Our homes provide children with a safe environment where they are given access to many opportunities that assist them in their development. TCCFC sponsors two children, David and Manju.

Door of Hope Preschool is located in Vavuniya in the north of Sri Lanka. It is predominantly made up of Tamil speaking children.

SRI LANKA VISIT

On Wednesday 28th February I met dad in Singapore before travelling on to Sri Lanka. We arrived in Colombo just after 9:00pm and were picked up from the airport by Pr Somanathan, our national CRC leader in Sri Lanka. Instead of staying in Colombo overnight and making the journey to the children's homes the following day, we drove through the night and reached Valaichenai in the early hours of Thursday morning.

Sadly Chrioni wasn't able to make this trip with us as we are still waiting on all of his documents to come together so we can apply for a passport. Please keep this in your prayers as we are both planning to come to Adelaide for a visit in May.

It was so good to be back in Sri Lanka. We spent just under a week in Valaichanai visiting the staff and children in the homes. It was an encouraging time and we were able to plan a lot of things that we hope to achieve in the coming months and years. Our children's homes are a fantastic ministry and it is an honour to visit and assist in any way possible.

One of the major tasks we hope to achieve is the ongoing development of our farm property. A number of years ago, Adelaide Christian Centre raised money for the establishment of a coconut plantation on the farm. This is something we hope to begin in the coming months. While we were on the farm, dad and Pr Somanathan measured the land and estimated how many coconut trees will fit.





We also hope to construct a house behind the existing small shop structure that is located at the front of the property. This will eventually be used to house two of the young people who are too old to remain in the homes. One of them has already left and is living on the farm property. His sister will leave next year or the following year and will move into the house when it is completed. We have made a commitment to taking care of these siblings, and their younger sister, beyond their time in the homes.

In addition to providing housing, we are looking at beginning a small bakery and part of this new facility will be used for that. This will provide employment for these two siblings and will assist in raising money and food for the homes. Produce from the farm will be sold in the small shop along with the baked goods.

On Tuesday 5th March, we travelled to Vavuniya where our preschool is located. We arrived in the night, stayed overnight in a hotel and visited the preschool the following day. The preschool has been running for 10 years and our staff have remained very faithful. I was inspired by their commitment to the work.

We travelled to Colombo after visiting the preschool and spent our final couple of days there. We had a nice time with Pr Somanathan and his wife Patricia before it was time to travel home. We flew out of Colombo on Friday 8th March and parted ways at Singapore airport. Dad flew back to Adelaide and I made my way back to Papua New Guinea. We may or may not have both cried a bit after saying goodbye to one another.

Last year they began a playschool for some weeks where children from the area came to the property with their parents for various activities. Asinate ran teaching classes for the children and they also involved the families in a sports day, as well as a picnic by the beach.

This playschool paved the way for a preschool to begin on the property they are living on. Bethel Christian Preschool Banban began on Monday 6th March. Asinate has reported that she has seven faithful children attending the preschool.

Pr Mike and Kelly Groom were able to bring many supplies for the preschool with them when they visited Vanuatu in February. They also helped prepare the room for Asinate so it was ready to go for the launch of the preschool.

In addition to opening the preschool, the Waris have also started a church on their property. Their first service was held on Sunday 5th March. They have 13 people faithfully attending the church.

They are doing a fantastic job. It is so encouraging to see a young couple serving as missionaries in another nation. Their dedication to the Lord and their commitment to following His plan in their lives is very admirable and a great inspiration for other young people.
